Assembly instructions

NECESSARY TOOLS

B&W Printer




Scissors or a cutter



Hole Puncher



12 square feet of leather




Thread and needles




PRINTING THE PATTERN

Set up your printer to A4 paper with no margins on landscape mode.

Alternatively you can use “letter” format which is approximately the same size and will not impact the size of the product



Print your patterns. Some of the parts need to be cut and pasted together as shown in the picture below



Use these templates to cut the leather and make the stitching holes. As always with any of my patterns EVERY STITCHING HOLE is precisely placed and necessary. The more accurate you mark them and make them the better the stitching will be

The build is quite simple so feel free to embellish and make it your own. I used a simple belt jsut to give it a more steampunk look but use your imagination and make this hat unique.
