NECESSARY TOOLS

B&W Printer



Scissors or a cutter



Hole Puncher (We recommend 1.5 - 1.8 mm sized holes for this build)



Approx 2.5-3.5 square feet of leather. (We recommend 5-6 oz leather for this build)



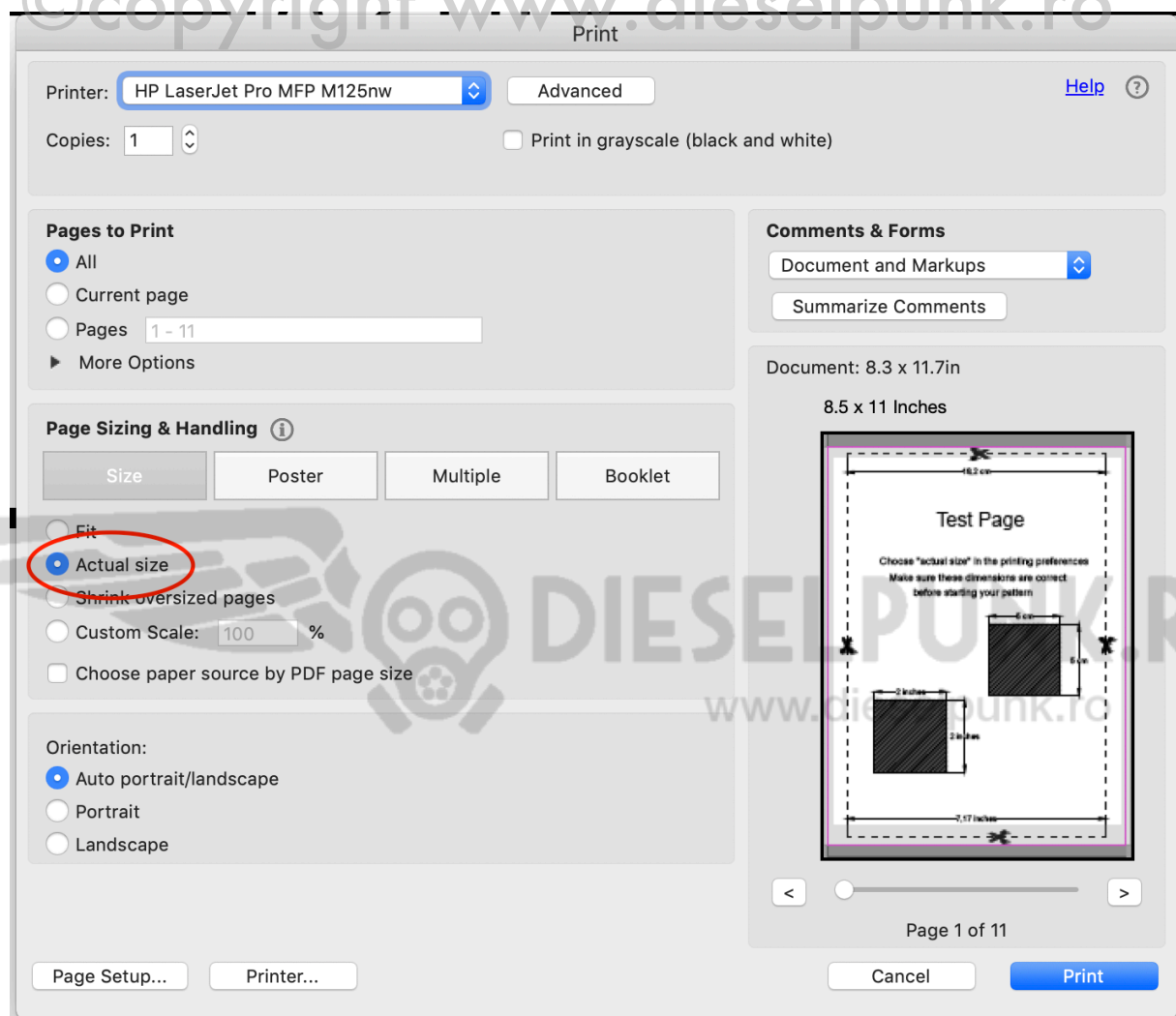
Thread and needles (We recommend 1 mm waxed thread for this build)

PRINTING THE PATTERN

Choose actual size in the printer settings

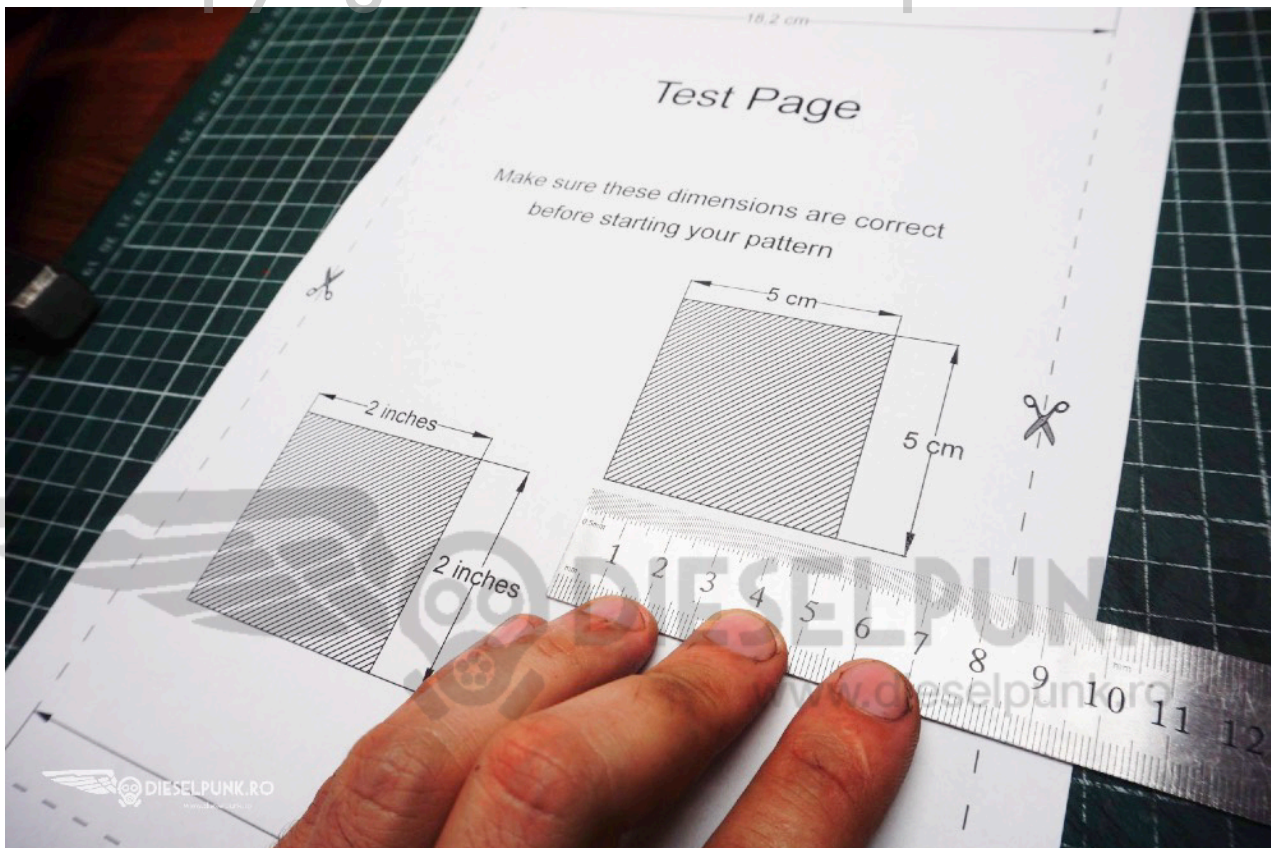


You can use A4, letter or Legal size paper as long as you print at 100% size

Print all the patterns.

The first page is a measuring reference and you can use a ruler to make sure it matches the square. That means the rest of the pattern will print on the right size

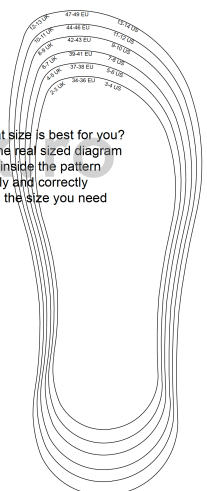


Take note that for the XL and XXL sizes some of the pieces are spread on two pages. Use the dotted line with the scissors to attach them together
